

Career Counselling Workshop

Dev Samaj College of Education, Sector-36-B, Chandigarh organized 3 days workshop on Career Counselling "Rekindle Psychological Assessment and Counseling Skills" in the college auditorium. The resource person for the workshop was Mr. Aadi Garg, a leading Psychologist and Career Counselor, Alumni (2015-16) and founder of AADI Career Guidance and Counselling Chandigarh.



DAY 1

Mr. Aadi Garg established a rapport with the students by giving his brief introduction and provided the students with a rough idea of what we were about to learn in the upcoming sessions. He began the session by explaining the students what exactly career counseling means and addressed career as ladder of occupations. He threw light on how to select one's career emphasizing on the importance of three D's, Discover, Devise and develop. He specified that in order to become an effective counselor, one should learn how to manage the three resources of time, money and energy efficaciously. He stressed upon the fact that investment begins at home and highlighted the five principles which included change, persistence, commitment, intrinsic motivation and emotional intelligence. During the second

session students were demonstrated the different types of assessment through collaborative learning and the students also performed the test.

Students were demonstrated and were given detailed explanation on how the various test were conducted starting with STANDARD PROGRESSIVE MATRICES (SPM), this test can be administered on an individual or a group to assess nonverbal intelligence in children or adult through abstract reasoning tasks.

DAY 2

The resource person started the Session I by summarizing the sessions of Day I. He also gave the students an overview of the topics and the assessment techniques to be discussed in today's sessions. He explained to the students about how to conduct counseling sessions and how to analyze and interpret the report. He trained the students to perform different intelligence tests. During the session II, the students performed the personality test along with a group activity

He explained about the counselling skills. The students were also taught about interpretation and analysis of the results of the various psychological tests. The students then participated enthusiastically in role play and other activities. The students enhanced their knowledge about the psychological tools as well as the counselling techniques during these three days. He mainly focused on "How to become an Effective Counselor"

The coordinators of the workshop were Dr. Ritu Mago and Mrs. Karuna Singh. The workshop was conducted specifically for the students of both the PG Diploma courses that is, Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance and Counselling as well as in Child Guidance and Family Counselling







All students of both the Diploma Courses attended this workshop enthusiastically and they were happy to participate in different activities with their peer group during this workshop. A formal vote of thanks was given by Dr. Ritu Mago, Coordinator of the workshop.
