- Material Resources : While planning and selecting material and equipment for AIL activities one can practice thumb rule of following five points resources should be Economical, Environment friendly, Reusable,
- Community Resources: Ways and forums to involve the local community meaningfully must be devised to develop a healthy and proactive community-school partnership.
- Space: It has been seen that in the traditional set up learning is very often confined to specific areas: whereas in AIL, it is recommended that the teacher needs to become more flexible while selecting and using learning spaces.

- Suggests ways for saving resources (forests, water, etc.) and shows sensitivity for the disadvantaged/deprived.
