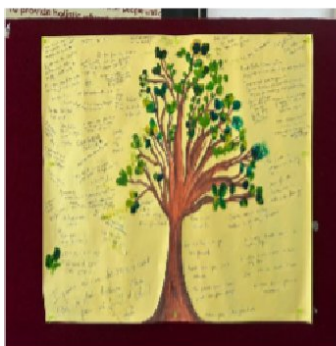

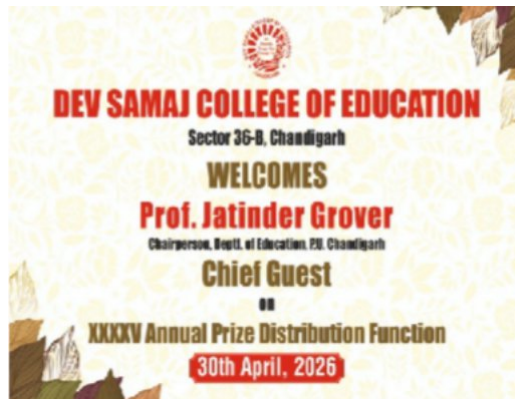
Activity 3: Message to Future Earth – Time Capsule

6. MERAKHI 2026 -CAREER EXHIBITION AND COUNSELING SEMINAR

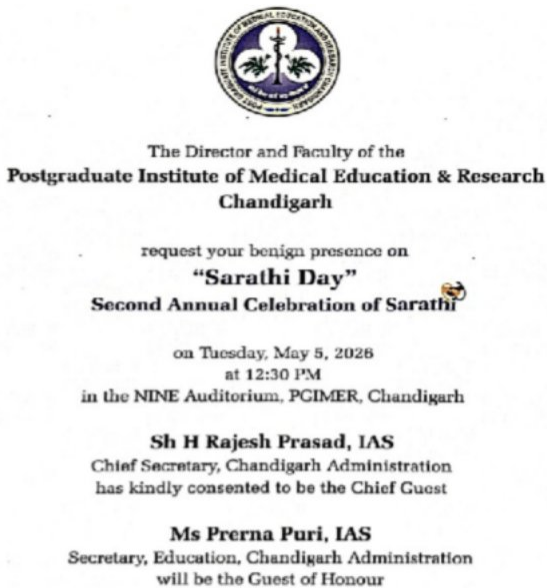
